Regulation 397/11 of the *Green Energy Act* requires that all public agencies are required to submit to the Ministry of the Environment and publish a summary of their most recent greenhouse gas emissions (GHG) and energy consumption data.

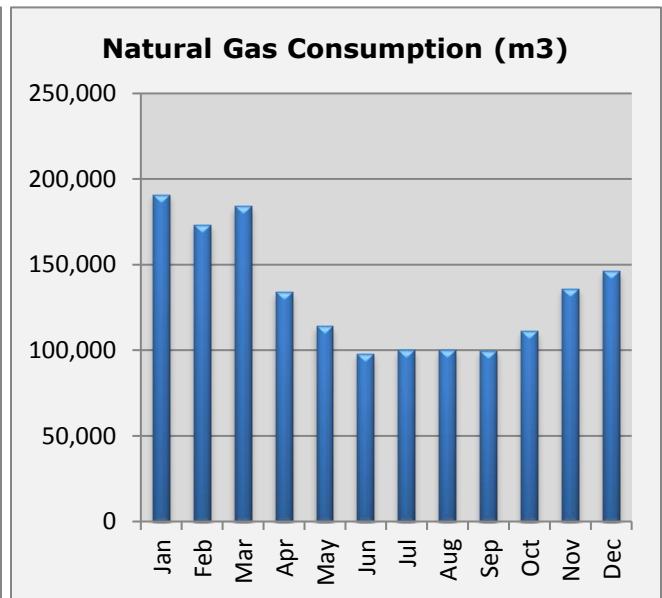
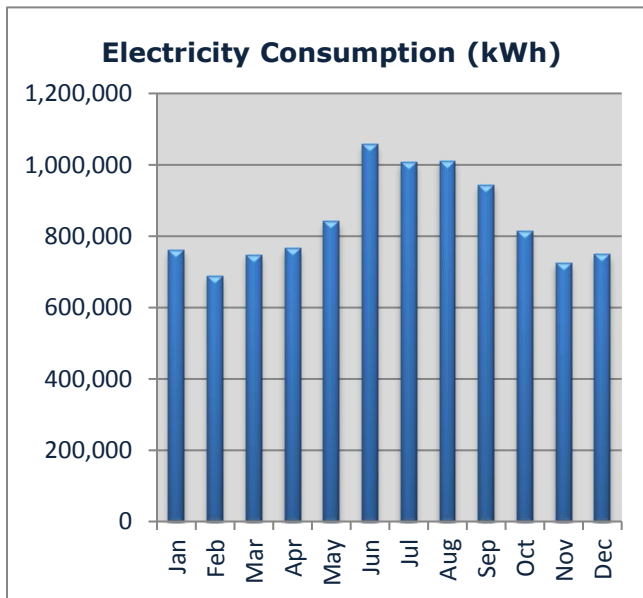

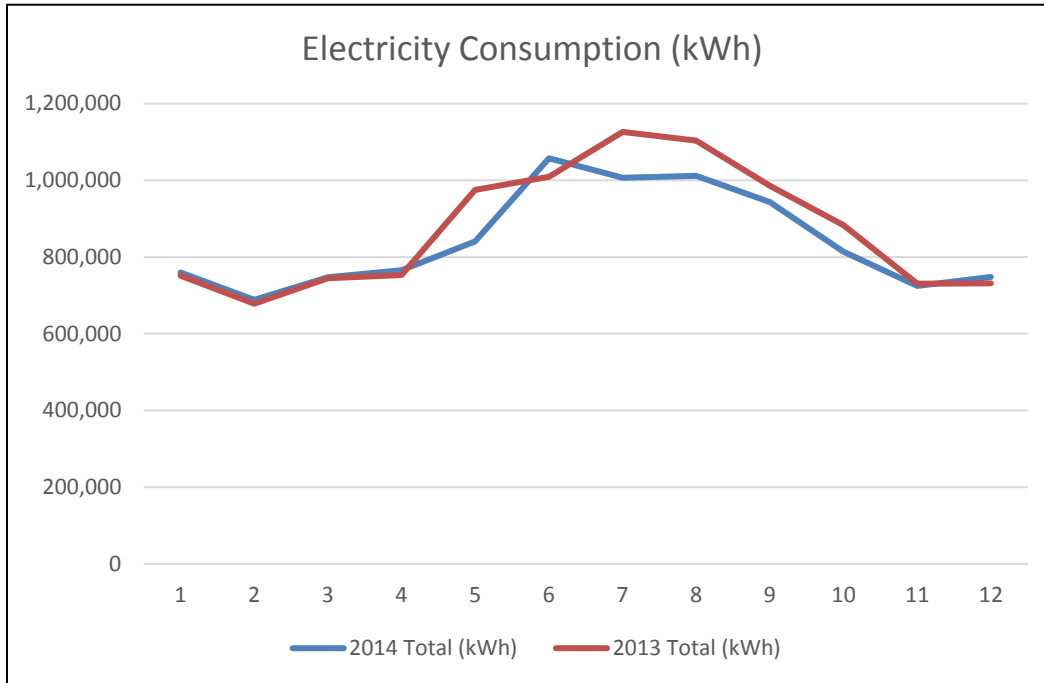
